5th

Convocation of

The 5th Convocation of Green University of Bangladesh was held on February 17, 2025. Professor Dr. S. M. A. Faiz, Chairman of the University Grants Commission (UGC), attended the ceremony as the Representative of the Honorable President and Chancellor and conferred degrees upon the graduates.

A total of 4,129 students received their degrees at the convocation. Among them, five students were awarded the Chancellor's Gold Medal and ten students received the Vice-Chancellor's Gold Medal.

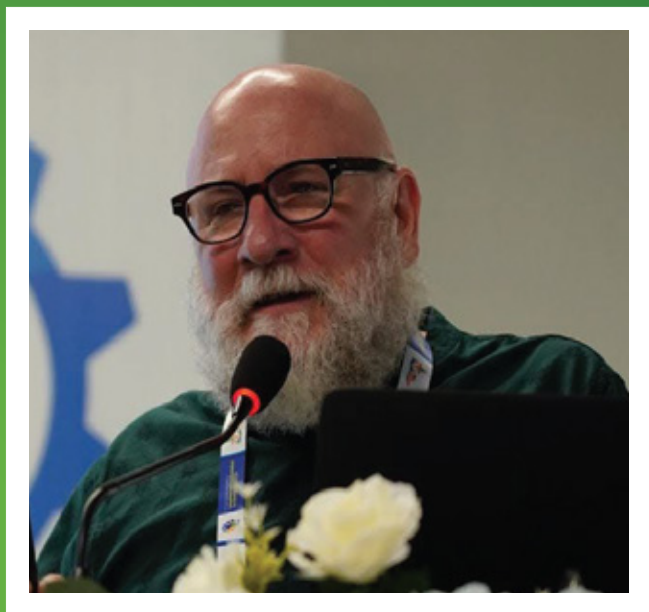
5. Keynote speech of ITD 2024, Day-2:

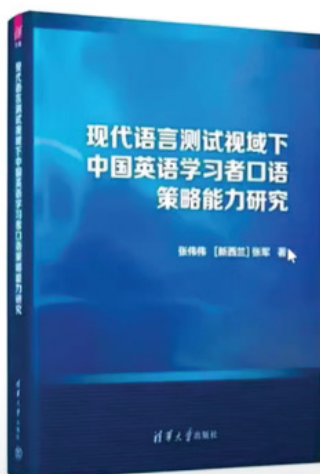
3. Moments of Merriment: Annual Picnic 2025, Department of English

4. Our webinar on 'Strategic Competence, Task Complexity and Learner Performance in Computer-Delivered Integrated Tests'

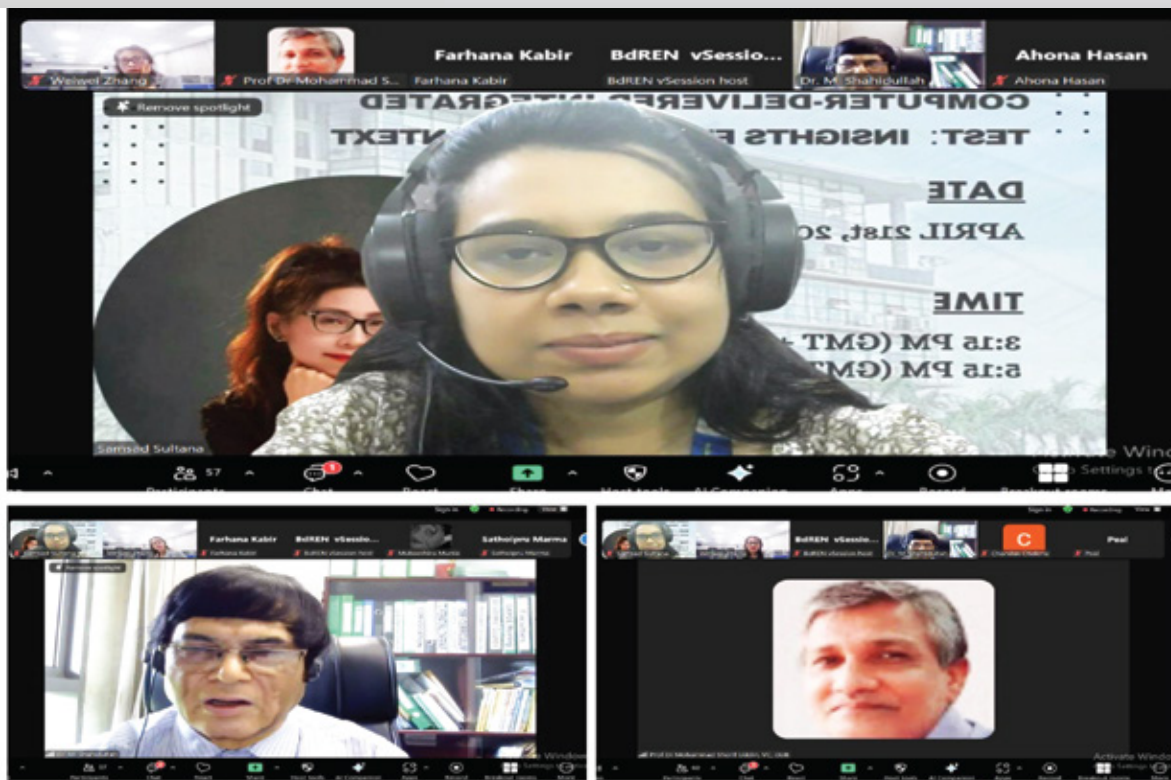

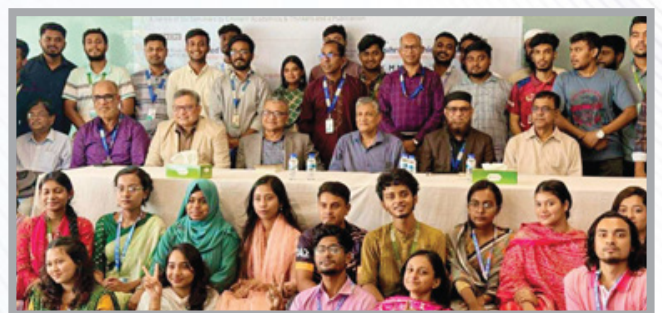
5. Seminar-Four: Frantz Fanon at 100: Decolonizing the Mind, Reimagining the World

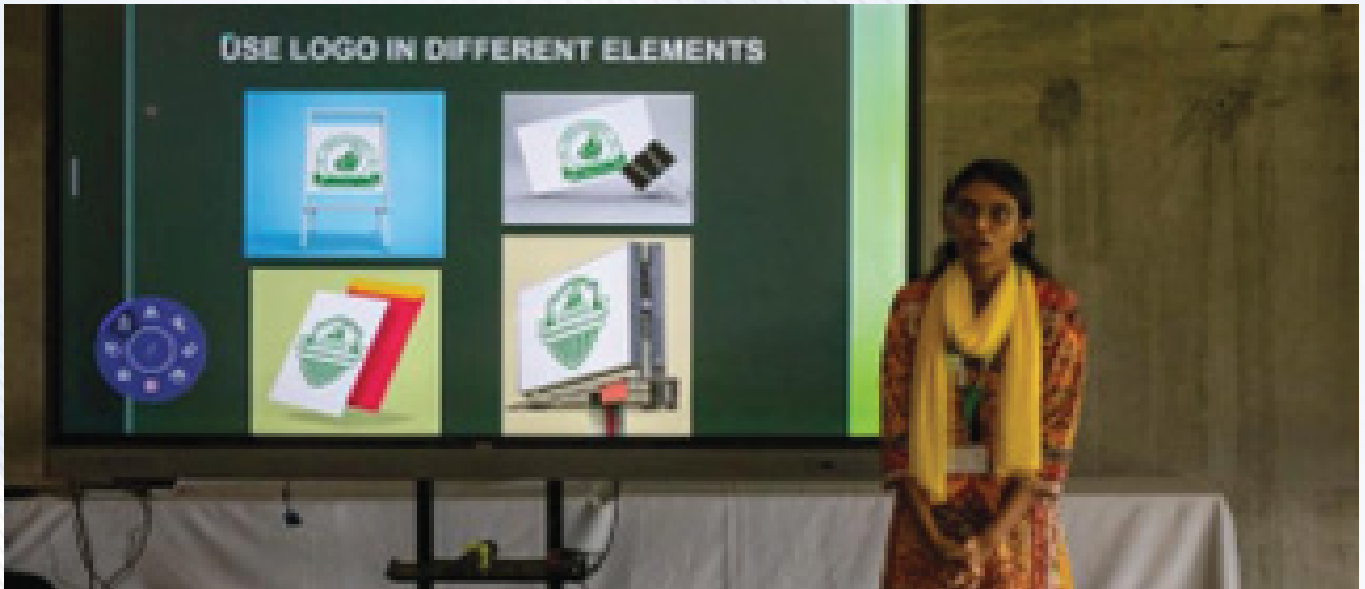


2. GUBC Logo Making Contest

3. Successful Completion of court visit at Dhaka Judge court

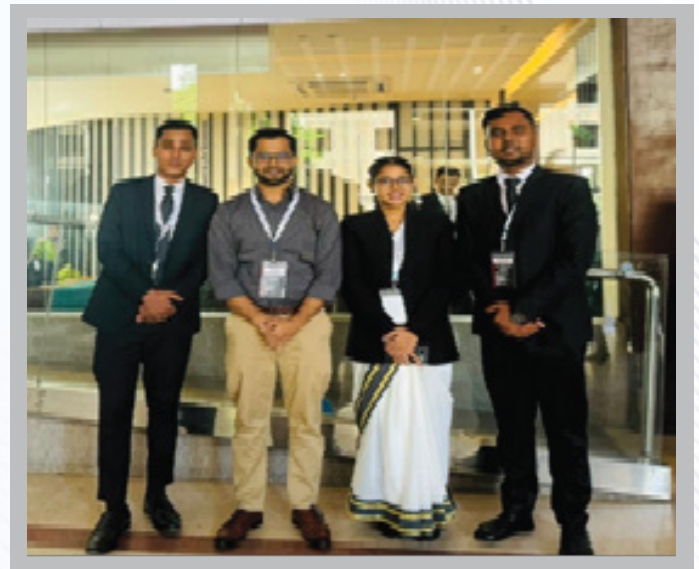

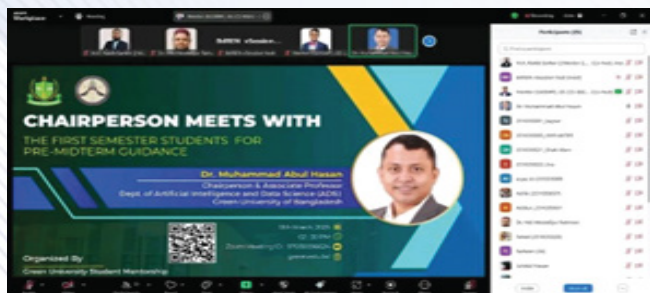


2. Library Orientation Program – Spring 2025 (Batch 251)

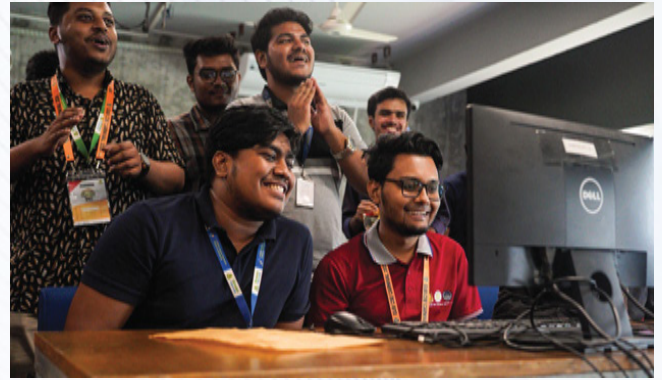

1. Industrial Visit at Giant Textiles Ltd. by the Department of Textile Engineering

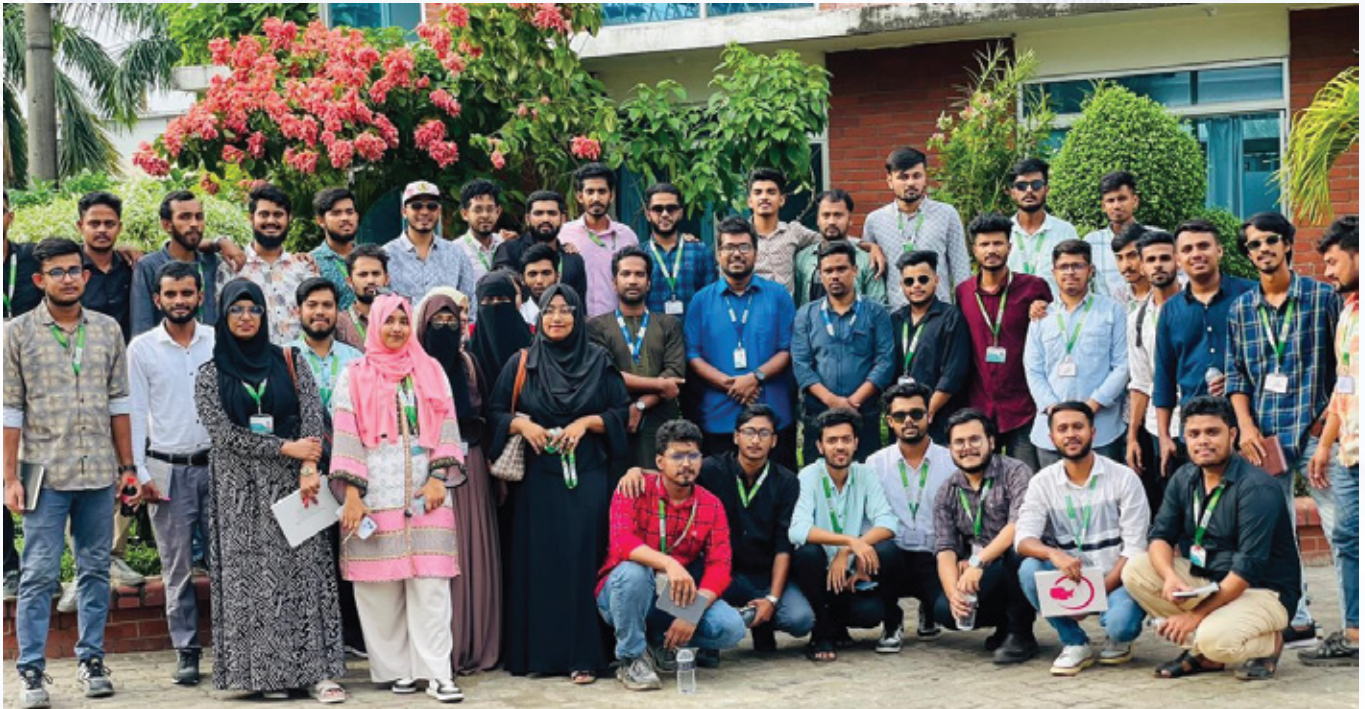

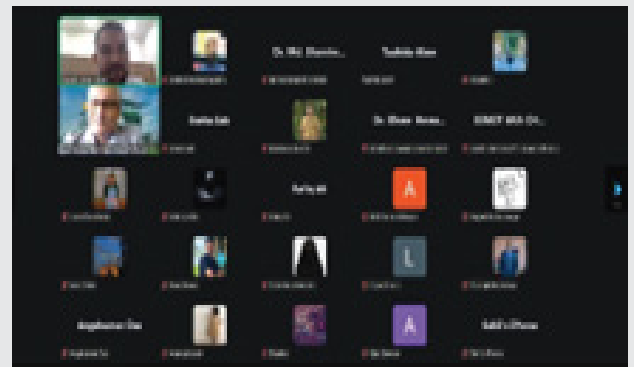
